

Cable tray front becomes back



Overview

Cable sag results from incorrect spacing of cable tray supports or from employing the incorrect tray type that is, light-duty perforated trays in high-load applications. Complicating the problem are overloaded trays and large unsupported spans. Sagging causes tension at. We're about to get new switches and they'll need to go in the front of the server cabinet.
