Wires in the junction box depend on the box size, wire gauge, and code rules. For example, a 4x4 inch box often holds up to 10 wires if you use 14-gauge conductors. We follow the 80% rule : Safe Continuous Load = Circuit Breaker Rating \times 0. 8
