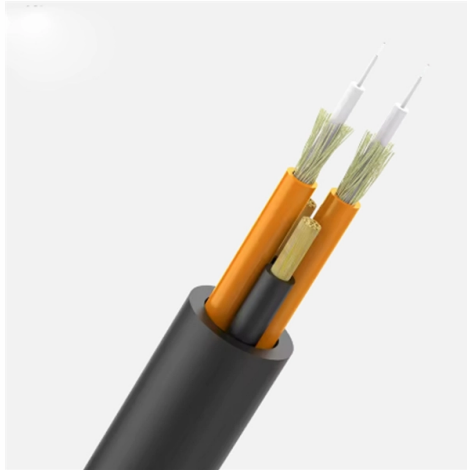


Communications Circle of the Burkina Faso Tower
