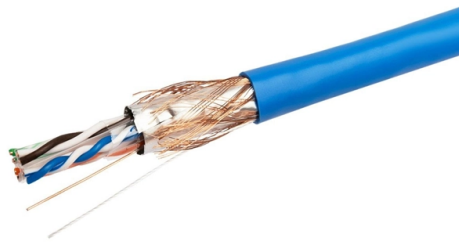

These rungs are spaced at regular intervals and provide a structure that resembles a ladder—hence the name. Alternative names include: cable runway and.
