

Environmental Requirements for Fireproof Cable Trays

Cable trays and busways at floor level or at slab penetrations shall have a waterstop no less than 50 mm in height. Sealing shall be tight and reliable, without visible cracks or. Cable tray installation must comply with specific technical standards to ensure electrical safety, system reliability, and long-term maintainability.
