

I want to move the router further away but the fiber optic cable is faulty



Overview

The typical solution is install the fiber modem in the best place for the fiber, and then run a single ethernet line to your router. If it's an all-in-one box you can probably get it changed. That thin white fiber cable has a minimum bend radius of somewhere around 10 cm, so if you pull it tight around a corner the glass inside it breaks. I recently got fibre broadband installed after moving house (went from 14mbps to 130mbps lol), it's great.
