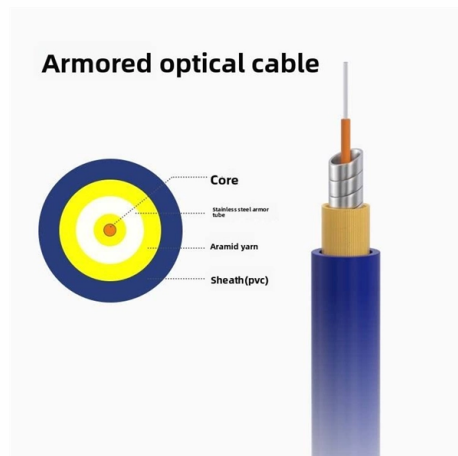


Is the network port panel for connecting a network cable or a fiber optic cable

It acts as a central point for neatly labeling and laying out all network cables, preventing tangled knots of CAT5 cables in a Local Area Network. A patch panel is a simple, passive device that serves as a physical interface for cable management.
