Cable Types: Only use conductors rated for open-air environments, such as Tray Rated (Type TC) or Metal-Clad (Type MC) cables. These systems, made from metal or plastic, are open structures designed to support electrical conductors, ensuring proper organization and safety. The key requirements for cable tray installation include: Incorrect installation can lead to overheating, cable damage, or system failure. Cable ladder systems and cable tray systems shall be manufactured in accordance with BS EN 61537, channel support. Cable tray installation must comply with specific technical standards to ensure electrical safety, system reliability, and long-term maintainability. Route. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend ra-dius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require.
