Interfaces: Electrical port modules use RJ45 interfaces, whereas optical port modules mainly adopt duplex LC interfaces, with simplex LC and MTP/MPO interfaces also available. Some functions can be configured on an optical interface only after the interface connects to a transmission medium (such as an optical module or copper module). Optical modules typically have an electrical interface on the side that connects to the inside of the system and an optical interface on the side that connects to the outside.
