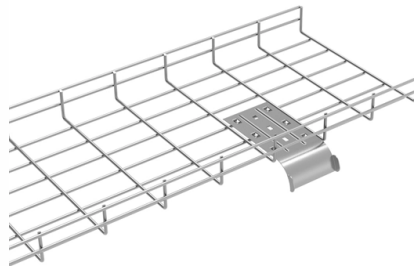


Parallel wiring of distribution box switch
