Choose the right box based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. (1) Power distribution from the primary main distribution board (distribution cabinet) to secondary distribution boards can be branched; that is, one main distribution board may supply power via multiple branch circuits to several secondary distribution boards. Electrical equipment is installed under the switch box, forming a three-level distribution. "Two level protection" mainly refers to the use of leakage protection measures.
