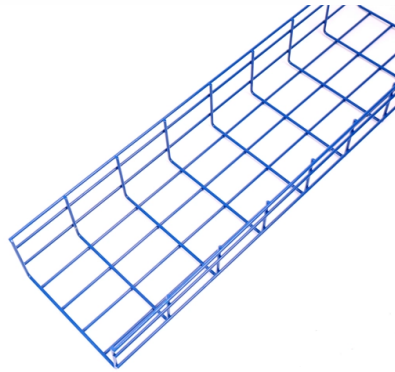


Telecom pigtail cable connection method
