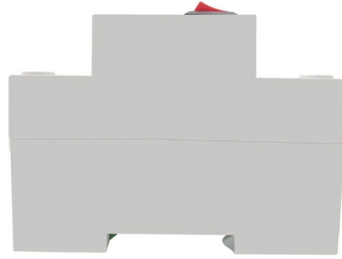


There is no electrical distribution box in the stairwell



Overview

If you cannot locate your distribution box after thorough searching, contact a licensed electrician. They can help identify your electrical panel location and ensure it meets current safety codes. Bottom Line Up Front: Your home's distribution box (electrical panel) is typically located in the basement, garage, utility room, or mounted outside near your electrical meter. To find it quickly, look for a rectangular gray metal box about the size of a medicine cabinet, often positioned close to. Perhaps, only distribution transformers can be placed there since they generally would not have any conduits. While not specifically excluded by the National Electrical Code (NEC), there are two code standards that a panel must comply with to be located under a stair: 1) The under-stair space is usally a closet, and a panel cannot be located in a closet near ignitable material [NEC 240. The escape stairs are linked by corridors which form part of the designated escape routes.
