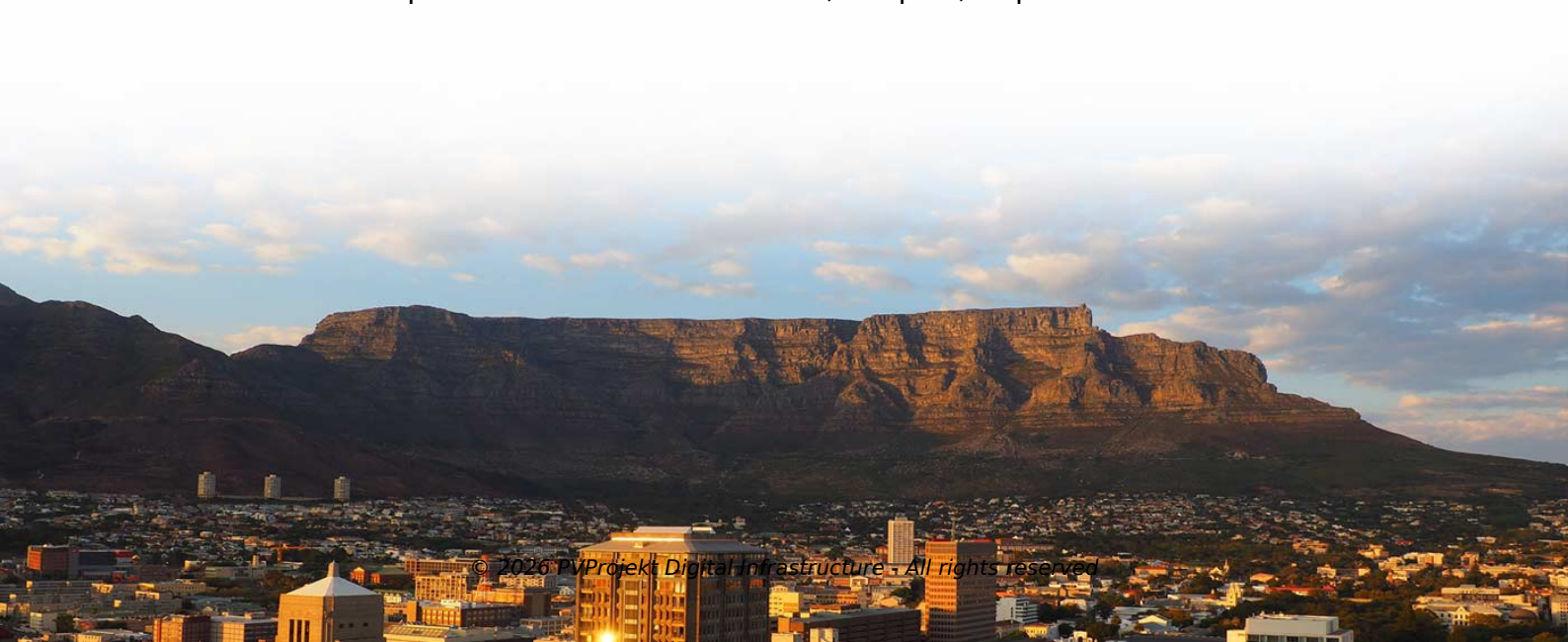


What color is best for the indicator light on a fiber optic router
