Unlike copper wires, which are limited by lower data transmission speeds, shorter transmission distances, and higher susceptibility to electromagnetic interference, fiber optic cables offer unparalleled performance and can cover much greater distances without bumping up against signal degradation. A fiber optic cable is a thin strand of glass or plastic that transmits data as pulses of light instead of electrical signals.) Multimode cable is made of multiple strands of glass. Fiber optic cable is composed of two layers of glass, the core, which carries the actual light signal, and the cladding, which is a layer of a glass surrounding the core. The cladding has a lower refractive index than the core.
