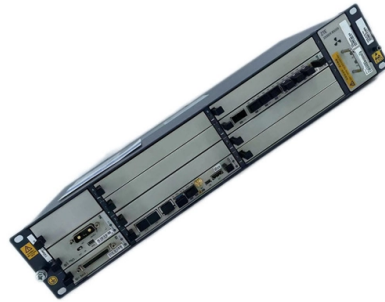


Where should the fiber optic splice be inserted



Overview

Insert the splices into the slots of the splice tray, managing any excess length by coiling it within the tray. Tray Closure: Place the lid over the splicing tray and press down to lock it into position. Unlike fiber connectors, which can be plugged and unplugged, splicing creates a fixed connection that is typically more stable and has lower insertion.
